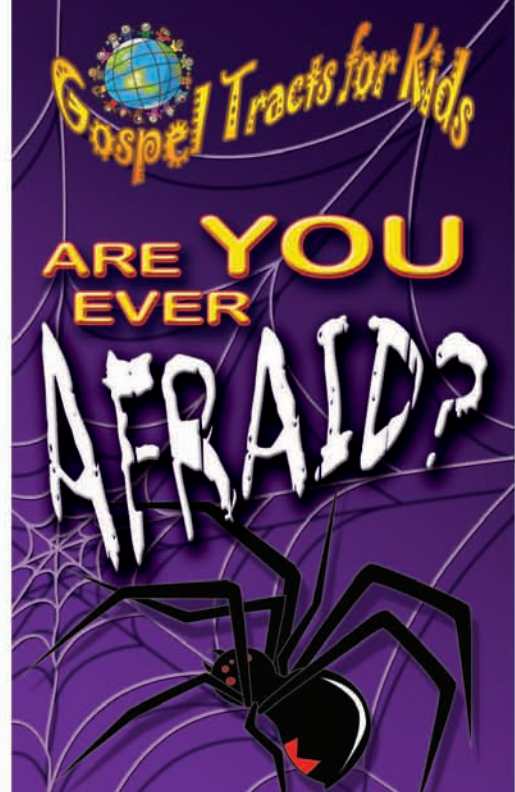

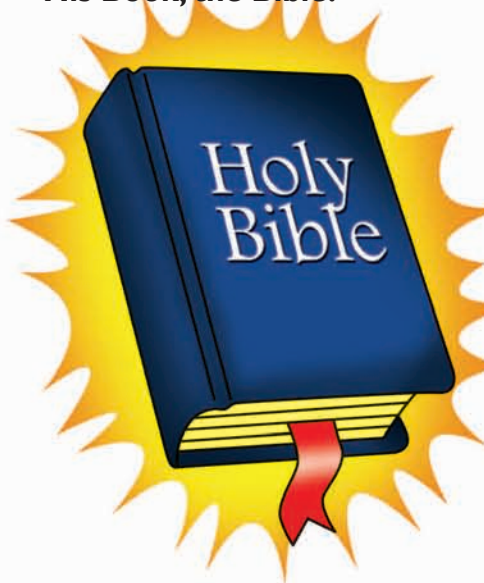

"... I am with thee, and will keep thee in all places whither thou goest ..."

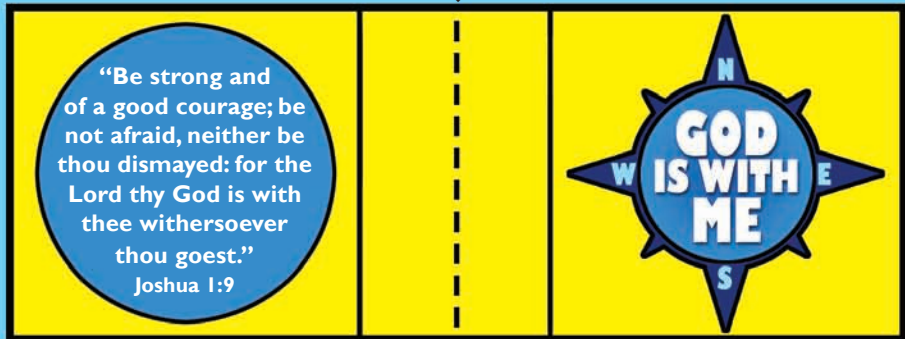
