**TAKE
COVER**



During the past few years an unusual amount of tornadoes and hurricanes have claimed the lives of many. The warnings were given, the sirens were sounded, the signals were sent out: a "killer" is on the way. So **TAKE COVER**. Be prepared lest the worst happen to you.

And while there are always those few who refuse to heed such warnings, by and large most people will listen. They will take heed. They will **TAKE COVER**, and by doing so, many precious lives will be spared from death.

Maybe you are one of those described earlier. You would not think of laughing at a tornado warning. If you saw one coming near you, you would immediately **TAKE COVER** and with

all your might try to escape being killed or injured in the storm. This makes good sense. But, dear reader, does it not make much more sense to prepare for eternity which will last millions upon millions of years? Death may come suddenly, and then it is all over. **But where you go after death is a pretty lengthy stay**. In fact, it never ends.

So, wherever you are when you read this little message, if you are not saved, do not wait one more minute. **TAKE COVER**. Prepare now to miss the wrath of God that awaits every unsaved individual. But how do I do it, you ask? Actually, it's simple if you are really serious. Just take God at His Word. Romans 3:23 tells us, *"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."* Romans 6:23 also tell us that, *"The wages of sin is death."* So, if we stay in our present state, we are headed straight for the judgment of Almighty God—spiritual death and Hell.
