

The Wonderful Name of Jesus

JESUS

The name **Jesus** is the most wonderful name ever uttered. The Bible says it is the ". . . name which is above every name . . ." The Bible uses about two hundred and fifty names for our Savior, yet none is more meaningful or more precious to the human heart than **Jesus**.

*Jesus! Name of priceless worth
To the fallen sons of earth
For the promise that it gave,
Jesus shall His people save.*

The wonderful name of Jesus should grip the heart of every family because it means Savior. ". . . thou shalt call his name **JESUS**, for he shall save his people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). In the entire universe nobody could conquer the terrible scourge of sin but wonderful Jesus! "Neither is there salvation in any other; for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

In the wonderful name of Jesus, fishermen conquered the heathen and broke down the cold walls of formal religion. Ungodly men became afraid of the wonderful name of Jesus. "But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name" (Acts 4:17).

But the followers of Christ had learned a wonderful secret. In the wonderful name of Jesus they had access to Heaven. They knew that God would heal and work signs and wonders "by the name" of His "holy child Jesus" (Acts 4:30).

In the wonderful name of Jesus a man crippled from birth was made to walk! "Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk" (Acts 3:6).

Unclean spirits lost their grip on men through the wonderful name of Jesus! ". . . But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour" (Acts 16:18).

It is the wonderful name of Jesus that gives us access to the throne room of the eternal Father in prayer. ". . . Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it to you" (John 16:23).

God gave wonderful Jesus to you, and in giving Him He gave all. "He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?" (Romans 8:32).

In the wonderful name of Jesus you can claim forgiveness, peace, joy, comfort, and Heaven! In Jesus, ". . . all things are yours" (1 Corinthians 3:21).

The wonderful name of Jesus unlocks the treasury of God. What do we need most? A car, employment, a new television set? No! It is the forgiveness of our sins that is our most urgent need.

It is through the wonderful name of Jesus that forgiveness of sins is granted to you. Instead of being condemned, you are forgiven! ". . . through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins" (Acts 10:43). "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit" (Romans 8:1).

We are to believe in His name for the forgiveness of our sins. He died for our sins! We are to be baptized in His name. We are to find victory in His name! We are to share His blessed name! We are to worship Him!

Jesus never changes. He is always the same. He is no respecter of persons. **No matter who you are or what you have done, Jesus will accept you!** He turns no one away. “. . . him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out” (John 6:37). Jesus is speaking to you today, through this tract. He wants you to know the fullness of joy and the completeness of forgiveness and deliverance in **His Wonderful Name!**
