You Don't Stand a Ghost

... of a chance of going to Heaven by living a good life or by the practice and profession of religion.

"What? No matter how good I am morally, no matter how religious I am and no matter how sincere—I don't have a ghost of a chance of going to Heaven that way?"

RIGHT!

Not only that, but the **only** way to Heaven is through a living Man, Who was dead, and Whom many believe to be a spirit—a ghost!

God says, *"All have sinned."* Romans 3:23. That "All" includes you. So what? Read Romans 6:23 *"... the wages of sin is death ..."*

You are a sinner, under the sentence of death—eternal separation from God. *"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."* Romans 5:8

He died for **you**, that He might bear the guilt and punishment of your sins. *"Who his own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree."* 1 Peter 2:24.

"... Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God." 1 Peter 3:18.

If **you** could blot out your sins and make yourself fit for Heaven, then Christ need not have died for your sins!

Note, that **he** might bring us to God." Only He—Christ can bring you to God. It is not religion or morality that saves.

"I'll take my chances without Him."

Without Christ you don't have a chance! *"...he that hath not the Son of God hath not life."* 1 John 5:12. Without the Lord Jesus you do not have eternal life—salvation.

There is just one way to Heaven—a person, the Son of God. He said, *"I am the way ... no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."* John 14:6.

Little one, believe what God says about you, that you are a sinner. Believe that Christ died to take your sins upon Himself and that He arose bodily from the dead.

Tell Him in your own words that you now trust Him to save you and that you receive Him by faith. *"...as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God."* John 1:12.

Many believe the Lord Jesus is a spirit—a ghost! But He said after His resurrection from the dead, *"Behold my hands and my*

*feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a **spirit** hath **not flesh and bones**, as ye see me have.” Luke 24:39.*

He is **not a spirit**—a ghost! He is the **Man** in the glory! *“For **there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.**” 1 Timothy 2:5.*

When you place your trust in the Lord Jesus for your salvation, He says you are saved! *“...He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.” John 6:47.*

So you can have “peace with God,” knowing for **certain** that you are saved.

And someday **your** body will be changed and fashioned like unto **His** glorious body! Philippians 3:21. That means you will not be a disembodied spirit—a ghost forever, but that all through eternity you too will have a real body in which you can enjoy Heaven!
